PARADE

Whether you're watching, taking part, or joining as a group, here's everything you need to know about York Pride's Parade.

York Pride Day gets off to a fabulous start with our Parade March through the streets of York, filling the city with colour, music, and celebration. Our loud and proud Parade is both a joyful statement of community and a march for equality and LGBTQ+ human rights in the UK and around the world.

This is our moment to show that York is a diverse, welcoming city where everyone belongs, and to send a clear message that hatred and prejudice have no place here.

Parade Route and Times

The Parade will assemble on Parliament Street between HSBC and M&S between 10:30am and 12:00 noon, with a pre-Parade party atmosphere in the city centre in the run up to departure. Arrive early to enjoy the music, colour, and community spirit as the Parade builds.

The Parade will depart at 12:00 noon, making its way through York city centre and along Bishopthorpe Road, arriving at the York Pride Festival site at the Racecourse on the Knavesmire at 1:30pm (approx.).

Watching the Parade

Everyone is welcome to come along and watch the Parade anywhere along the route. Popular viewing spots include Parliament Street, Coney Street, and Bishopthorpe Road.

These areas can get busy, so we recommend arriving early to secure a good viewing spot and enjoy the atmosphere as the Parade passes by.

Key Things to Know

The York Pride Parade is approximately 2.4 miles long and typically takes 60–90 minutes to complete.

Please:

- Wear comfortable footwear
- Bring water
- Prepare for all weather conditions (sun cream, hats, rainwear as needed)
- Flags, banners, and placards are welcome, provided they are positive, inclusive, and respectful.
- Dogs are welcome to join the Parade but must be kept on a lead and under control at all times.
- When the Parade reaches the Knavesmire, participants are asked to move promptly and safely into the festival site so the Parade route can be cleared efficiently.

HOW MUCH IS ENTRY TO THE YORK PRIDE FESTIVAL?

York Pride is a free, family-friendly event! Whilst there is no entry fee, donations are welcome to ensure that the event can continue in the future.

HOW DO I FIND THE YORK PRIDE FESTIVAL SITE?

The York Pride main festival event is held on the Knavesmire, next to York Racecourse.

CAN I PARK MY CAR AT THE YORK PRIDE FESTIVAL?

Unfortunately we have no car parking facilities at the Knavesmire site - we have limited parking for those with a blue badge only. If you have a blue badge there is no need to book this just turn up on the day with your blue badge. Please note that only resident permit holders can park in most nearby streets.

IS FOOD AND DRINK AVAILABLE ON THE FESTIVAL SITE?

Yes! We have a wide range of food stalls on the day, including plant-based and gluten-free options, together with a large fully licenced bar selling alcohol and soft drinks.

CAN I BRING MY OWN FOOD AND DRINK TO YORK PRIDE?

Yes you can! Note that no glass should be brought onto the site. Please help us keep the Knavesmire nice and tidy by putting any rubbish or recycling in one of the many bins available.

IS THE SITE ACCESSIBLE?

At York Pride we want everyone to celebrate with us, so we have many provisions and facilities in place to ensure we all have a great day - check out our Accessibility Guide for full details

Our event is held on an open grass field, which can be uneven in places.

We have 500 meters of track way path to make key points of the site accessible.

We also have an accessibility ramp and a raised viewing platform facing the main stage, together with fully-accessible disabled toilets. There is a small amount of parking available on site for those with a blue badge.

Please speak to a Marshal on the day for further help and advice. If you do have any special requirements email us at info@yorkpride.org.uk and we will do our best to assist.

IS THERE A 'QUIET HOUR' AT THE FESTIVAL?

York Pride will have a 'Quiet Hour' on the festival site from 11:30am, before the parade arrives, where the site and stalls can be enjoyed without the crowds, music and noise.

IS THE FESTIVAL FAMILY AND DOG-FRIENDLY?

Yes, we welcome all families to our event! Furry members of the family are welcome too - please be mindful that large crowds will be present, keep them on a lead and please clean up after them!

ACCESSIBILITY FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

AT YORK PRIDE WE WANT EVERYONE TO CELEBRATE WITH US SO WE'RE COMMITTED TO ACCESSIBILITY. HERE ARE SOME OF THE FACILITIES WE HAVE IN PLACE TO ENSURE WE ALL HAVE A GREAT DAY...

THE PARADE

Our Pride Parade is one of the longest in the country at 2.4 miles, and takes around 60-90 minutes to complete. It follows the public highway and so is relatively flat, however we do go over a few cobbled streets but this is unavoidable on our route.

We have a number of places for wheelchair users on the buses within the parade. If you would like one of these please contact our Parade team in advance at parade@yorkpride.org.uk.

FESTIVAL SITE DESCRIPTION

The main Festival event is held on the Knavesmire, which is a large area of open grassland. The site is level but can be uneven in places. There will be a ramp from the main gateway on Knavesmire Road into the site. If you need any help or support, please speak to one of our Marshals who will be wearing yellow high visibility vests.

There are no doors or gates to open to enter the site, or around the festival apart from the portals. There are two fully-accessible Mobiloos, which will be staffed.

CAR PARKING

We have limited parking for those with a blue badge. If you have a blue badge there is no need to book this, just turn up on the day with your blue badge.

ACCESSIBLE TRACKWAY

We have accessible trackway at key points around the site, including from Blue Badge parking area to the viewing platform.

QUIET HOUR

There will be a 'quiet hour' on the festival site between 11.30am and 12.30pm to enable people to enjoy the festival and visit the stalls without loud music and crowds. The Parade is expected to reach the Festival between 1pm and 1.30pm, when the site will become much busier and acts will take to the stages.

STROBE LIGHTING

Although we are not planning to have strobe lighting, there will be some lighting effects including some programmed flashing light and moving head lights on the Main Stage. There may also be some lighting effects on the YO1 & Queer Arts stages.

VIEWING PLATFORM

We are providing a raised platform viewing area facing the Main Stage, accessed by a ramp, for wheelchair users or those with restricted mobility.

There will be a large screen next to the Main Stage for increased visibility of the performances.

HEARING ACCESS

The Main Stage will have BSL interpreters on throughout the day.

ACCESSIBLE TOILETS

This year there are two Mobiloos on site located on the trackway route close to the accessible viewing platform and our Pride HQ. A Mobiloo is a mobile fully-accessible toilet with an adult-sized changing bench, a hoist and a friendly attendant.

Both toilet blocks on the site also have accessible toilets.

BABY-CHANGING FACILITIES

The accessible toilets also have baby-changing facilities.

MEDICAL FACILITIES

There are medical teams on site, as well as an ambulance.

ASSISTANCE DOGS

Service animals are welcome at York Pride! They must be kept on a lead at all times and please pick up after them and bring along any food they need and water bowl for them too.

Please note that shade is limited on the site and it can get very hot and crowded.
